Definitions of Games Played

1-2-1	Best 1 of 4 on par 3s, best of 2 on par 4s, best of 1 on par 5s
All Fours	Total net score of all par 4s
All Good Things	Player earns points on each hole for: tee shot on fairway, getting to green in regulation, only using 2 putts or less, and scoring par or better. One point for each, max 4 points per hole.
Best 9 Holes	Player chooses either the Front 9 or Back 9 as her best net score
Best Ball Threesome	The best net score of the hole is the team score for each hole
CCC Challenge Cup	Format 6-6-6 (match play in each format). Players form their own team of 2 Holes 1-6 is a 2-person Shamble (1 best ball of 2). Both players tee off each hole, pick best drive and play your own ball in from there. The team score will be the 1 best ball of 2. Holes 7-12 is a Modified Alternate Shot. Both players tee off each hole, pick best drive and alternate shots until ball is holed. Holes 12-18 is 1 Best Ball of 2 Each match is worth a total of 3 points. Each 6-hole match is worth 1 point and a ½ point for a tie.
Chicks with Sticks	All players are divided into 2 teams, Blue and Red. Then teams are 2-person with 1 Best Ball of 2, net match play. Each match is worth a total of 1 point, tie is worth ½ point.
The	overall Chicks with Sticks winner will be the team with most combined points.
Easy Peasy	Total net score of the nine easiest holes of the course which are 4,5,6,7,10,11,12,13,18
F&T	Count scores on Holes 2,3,4,5,10,12,13,14,15
Individual Gross/Net	Each player's best gross score and best net score
Jessie Rice Tourney	Total low net score for the 2 rounds
Kentucky Derby	Best ball threesome. Win, Place and Show awarded. Trophy.
Net Skins	Player with the lowest net score on a hole wins a skin. If 2 or more players tie, no skin is awarded. Skins do not carry over to next hole if there is a tie.
O.N.E.S.	Count scores on 1,6,7,8,9,11,16,17,18
Par 3	All holes will be set up to be Par 3. Best ball of threesome.

Red & Green Tees	Player alternates teeing off from red and green tees.
Ringer Tourney	This is a 2-week tournament. After 2 weeks, player's best net score on each hole will be chosen. Total net score wins.
Roll the Dice	After ball is holed, one player of threesome will roll dice to determine which player's score will be used for the hole.
S&T	Count scores on Holes 2,3,6,7,10,12,13,16,17
Stableford Birdie=3pts	Points are awarded on each hole based on player's net score: Eagle=4 points, Par= 2pts, Bogey=1pt
Strike 3	Player will throw out their highest score of one par 3, one par 4 and one par 5.
